

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#### **COMMUNITY IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS**



At the January Board of Directors meeting, the board approved the installation of a fence at the South end of Heron Watch Place. The fence was installed in March and improves the look of our community.

SLOW DOWN PLEASE! This is the second tree in the last few months that has been downed by an out-of-control driver. It is especially concerning that one of the drivers was a neighbor. It would have proved deadly had people been on the sidewalk. So PLEASE SLOW DOWN.





In late March our well that provides water to our common grounds was malfunctioning and subsequently went out completely. It had exceeded the lifespan a couple years ago. A new well pump and controls were installed March 28th and now it is working great. It has noticeably improved out irrigation output.

The quarterly planting was completed the first of March. Despite setbacks which have included watering issues and theft, it looks great!

The next quarterly assessment is due on April 1st and late after April 11th. There are numerous ways to pay your assessment:

1) Mail a check payable to The Estuary Homeowners Association with the coupon that you received last December.

2) Many online payment options, including Auto Pay, Bill Pay and Credit Card are available. Please visit the Association's website and look for Online Assessment Payments on the left hand side of the home page. This link will take you to the Truist Bank Portal.

**DON'T FORGET**: When pushing an online payment forward through the Online Payment Screen, remember that you MUST place the amount that you wish to pay in the "Pay Amount" box (defaults to 0.00).

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## **NEWS FROM YOUR HOA BOARD**



There is a lot happening to maintain and upgrade the appearance and infrastructure of The Estuary.

The Grounds Committee has done a great job of planning and coordinating the early Spring plant of the front flower bed. Some flowers and plants have been stolen, so if you see someone take plants, let us know. The pump outage damaged some plants but there were enough surplus annuals purchased to replant the same plants.

The Architectural Review Committee has been very timely in processing all requests as homeowners seek to improve their property and home values.

The Spirit Committee continues to plan monthly food truck events which have been a huge success. They also have publicized their yearly Spring Garage Sale and will sponsor the Easter Egg Hunt. The new residents to The Estuary have received Welcome Baskets.

At the last meeting of the BOD, it was approved to have more input into any changes made to the Community Standards. The proposal was to have changes presented at the annual membership meeting for a vote of members present.

Other business items were:

- A fence extension at the South end of Heron Watch Place was approved and has been constructed.
- Funds to clean up Rice Creek where the cold weather killed invasive species.
- Continued repair of the irrigation system which now has minor maintenance requirements.
- We did have emergency repair on our well to replace the pump. It had outlived it's life cycle by several years and now is working very efficiently.

Comments continue to be very positive from perspective homeowners who become residents because of both the "curb appeal" and great spirit of our community. Home values have risen and the sense of community continues to be strong as we work together as a neighborhood.
