

#### **HOA PRESIDENT'S COMMENTS ON 2019 AND REZONING**

Greetings and Happy New Year! It has been overwhelming to be elected and immediately have the challenge of two rezoning actions as well as a new accounts manager with our landscaping company. It appears the rezoning action west of Heron Watch will not affect us but I do appreciate residents attending that meeting since I was out of town.

The second issue has a good possibility of affecting us and it is vital that we come together as a community. A Board of three or four members attending the Zoning Officer hearing or the Board of County Commissioners will not be effective in changing the course set at this time. It is going to take many of us as Estuary Residents to stand up against the attempted rezoning proposal. It is my goal, that together we can terminate the extension of Heron Watch to Rhodine Road. I certainly hope that many residents will come out and speak against that proposal as well as just be a visible presence objecting to this rezoning attempt.

This will be our major effort for the next few months, however we will not neglect other issues as we strive for excellence. Directors of the Board met with the account manager for Brightview Landscaping Company. They have committed to improve our services, however we will be meeting monthly to ensure services are maintained at their contracted level. Some deficiencies have already been corrected and we will inspect to ensure they remain corrected. During our meeting, we addressed the unremarkable appearance of our entryway and asked that Brightview propose a plan more appealing to that area. The planting of flowers in late fall were definitely poor quality. The outcome of the current replanting undertaken in mid December will continue to be monitored. I know many of you, like myself, desire our community to be maintained in a very professional and attractive manner. We are striving for that and hope to have a grounds or land-scaping committee forming to assist us in that endeavor. Many of these efforts are like plants, they do take a little time to develop, but if done right, they can be very rewarding. I will attempt to keep you apprised of the activities that the committees and the Board of Directors are doing. I will indeed actively solicit your help on projects like defeating the rezoning efforts that likely will degrade the integrity of our community.
