The Spirit Committee wants to remind everyone to be safe during this first real holiday since the lock down of COVID19. If you will be gathering in large crowds, consider wearing your masks. If you don't feel quite right, don't go! We want everyone to continue to enjoy getting back together with friends and family.

It is also important to remember fire safety. Each year there are fireworks that we see all around us. This year we are told that we are in a drought. The draught is the very reason that watering our yards has been cut back to one day a week. With that, the grass and the timbers around us will be even drier than usual and more susceptible to catching fire. Sparklers are

the only item permitted in the neighborhood and since there is a draught, if they are permitted, they should be used with discretion.

I would also like to remind everyone that fireworks cause many soldiers, sailors and airmen to have recurring PTSD episodes. Their service was given as a gift to each of us and we want them to be able to return to America and heal. Be thoughtful of them. Along with the service men and women who have a difficult time with fireworks we also have many beloved animals that do not do well. We just ask you to be thoughtful and mindful of all of those who are negatively impacted by the loud explosions of the fireworks.

All in all, we want you to be safe and have a great and happy 4th of July as we get back to what we used to call "normal"!

NOTES FROM THE BOARD

The next Board of Director's meeting will be July 15th at 6:30 PM via ZOOM. The annual membership and budget meeting is scheduled for October 21, 2021 at 6:30 PM and is planned to be in person.

As a condition of residency within The Estuary, each homeowner agreed to abide by the Community Standards. A reminder that we have two community garage sales per year. Garage sales outside of the community events are not permitted. Likewise, modifications to the exterior of your home need to be approved by the Architectural Committee which means that an Alteration Application must be submitted for approval.

TECO has our electrical hookup for the Park and aeration for the Albatross pond scheduled for early August which will meet a long-standing goal.

A special thank you to all of you who signed the lighting petition. We now have over 200 signatures to provide to TECO. Your support is much appreciated!
